



FOCUS ON HUNGER

Story County has **23 food pantries** currently and numerous food programs.

IN ONE MONTH **5,492** INDIVIDUALS WERE SERVED BY STORY COUNTY PANTRIES.

The **SHOP** has been a recipient of funds and donations from United Way's annual **LIVE UNITED Food Drive**. ISU staff also participate in **UWSC's Hunger Collaboration** to work together to address hunger in our county.

ISU's student-run pantry, **The SHOP**, housed at 1306 Beyer Hall, had 3,961 visits during the '21-22 academic year. Since summer 2022, they have already had 4,791 visits! In the last year, 2 new pantries were added on campus at Vet Med and at Sloss House.

In the fall of 2021, ISU students experiencing low to very low food security increased to over 31%. A spring 2022 survey found over 88% felt The **SHOP** has helped them attend/participate in classes and other campus activities.
