**K**elly works at Friendship Ark Homes, a United Way of Story County partner agency, celebrates the uniqueness of adults with intellectual disabilities by providing homes and community services. Caring providers at our partner agencies are a critical component of medication management. A recent United Way Community Impact grant provided laptops to enhance efficiency and safety in documenting medication for 33 residents at 7 homes. Providing correct and individualized care is a top priority – and documenting each medication is crucial. The enhanced technology keeps the focus on the population being served while helping to ease the process of documentation for staff.

Grants for things like medication management are just one way United Way funds help provide for the mental health services our community needs.

Other services that are funded include

- Therapeutic services, including evaluations and counseling
- Mental health awareness programming
- Programming that improves access to social or emotional supports for youth to seniors
